WHEREAS:

a majority of the total number of businesses with employees in the state; and

WHEREAS: Numerous entities, including the Georgia Centers of Innovation, the joint economic

> development committee of the Senate and House of Representatives, and many others are committed to helping our businesses grow and creating new jobs within the state by providing exemplary workforce training, financial assistance programs.
